Several of our Florida District congregations are at similar thresholds, having reached significant milestones or are in the midst of a leadership transition. Still others are eager to move off a plateau to grow Unitarian Universalism and their ministries. At such junctures, it is always good to return to basic questions of purpose, identity, and uniting values.

This workshop has two elements: An experiential engagement with:

- Core Values: What, as Unitarian Universalists and as members of our congregation, do we most prize?
Mission: Why do we exist at all. What is our Purpose?
Mission-Field: Whom are we serving now? Whom will we serve in 3, 5, or 10 years?
Gifts: What is our congregation uniquely gifted to do in our setting?
Vision: How would we as a congregation, how might our neighborhood or community, be different were we to succeed with our Mission?

Part two will see congregational groups developing their unique 1 & 3 year goals for:



- Worship
Faith Development - Children
Faith Development - Adults
Building Community
Practicing Our Faith, individually & as a congregation
Organizational Maturity & Leadership Development

The day concludes with each congregation covenanting in partnership with a similar congregation for mutual future support.
