Right Relations workshop

Having adopted a **Covenant of Right Relations** at our congregation, we are holding a workshop for our members to explore its meaning and to learn how to effectively apply it.

We extend an invitation here to our neighbor Florida District congregations to join us. District Consultant **Kelly Belanger Harris** will be our presenter.

The **Covenant of Right Relations** is a set of guidelines designed to create a "welcoming, respectful, safe, and vibrant spiritual community," to help Unitarian Universalist members engage each other appropriately.

The **Covenant** calls for members to listen attentively, to express gratitude, to value confidentiality, to respect different opinions, to ask for help, and to "acknowledge that everyone makes mistakes." It is part of what furthers the Beloved Community of Faith.

Having a **Covenant** also helps congregational leaders think about how to handle a conflict in a positive way. The heart of the covenant is that, besides expressing our emotions and differences in respectful ways, we approach disagreements constructively.

This workshop is an opportunity to learn how to settle disagreements before they turn into conflict. Please join us.
