- * What motivates volunteers?

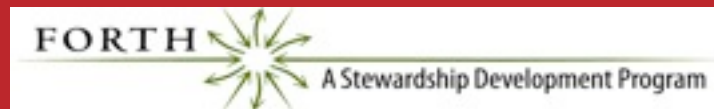
