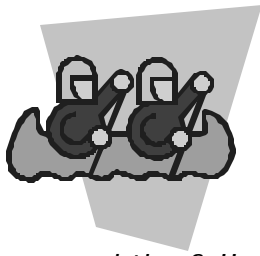

Please read the following information, then complete and mail the registration form on back along with your check.

Registration:

- **Adult Registration fee: \$65**
- In an effort to keep the cost of this retreat as low as possible we have arranged a labor exchange with UU in the Pines. The retreat center requests four hours of much needed labor from each individual in exchange for the reduced rate. **If you would prefer not to work and would rather pay full price the registration fee is \$100.** Please bring insect repellent, work clothes, and gloves for the volunteer work scheduled.
- **Child registration fee for age 4-14: \$30** (There is no fee for children under 3. Age 15 and over are considered adults.)
- Registration fee includes two nights and six meals. All meals will be vegetarian. Coffee and tea are also included, but there is no soda machine. There is a refrigerator available for drinks and snacks brought by individuals. **PLEASE BRING SNACKS TO SHARE!**
- Limited scholarships are available. Please send an email to uuretreat@yahoo.com if you are in need of a scholarship.
- If you would like to stay an extra night the cost is \$20 per person not including meals. There are restaurants in the area and a kitchen available for use. The decision to stay an extra night does not need to be made ahead of time.

Child Care:

- A paid child care specialist will be present at no extra cost.
- Parents will be required to volunteer in the child care area for one time slot, which is three hours. This will ensure both a low child to adult ratio and a high quality experience for the children.
- Participants who are not parents but would like to volunteer in the child care area are welcome. Please check the child care box in the return portion of the registration form if you are interested in being a child care volunteer.
- A medical release and information form must be submitted for each child attending the retreat.
- UU in the Pines requires that children under age 18 be accompanied by their own parent in the pool.

Miscellaneous Information:

- **Registration opens at 6:00 p.m. on Friday, September 3rd. Opening circle is at 9:00 p.m.** Closing circle will take place on Sunday, September 5th. Those who are scheduled to go canoeing will leave from the retreat center at 3:00 p.m. and return to the retreat center at 6:00 p.m.
- There is a ten-mile downstream stretch of the Withlacoochee River available for canoeing with a drop off and pick up service provided. **The fee is \$25 dollars per canoe, and three people can fit in each canoe.** The number of people interested in canoeing needs to be submitted to the retreat center administrator ahead of time. If you are interested in canoeing, please check the box in the return portion of the registration form.

Things to Bring:

- Anyone interested in helping to plan Saturday evening's worship service can bring materials.
- Please bring your own sheets, pillowcases, towels, and bath articles.
- Bring a bathing suit if you would like to swim in the pool.
- You are strongly encouraged to bring musical instruments.
- Anyone who would like to contribute materials to the craft area can bring arts and craft materials.
