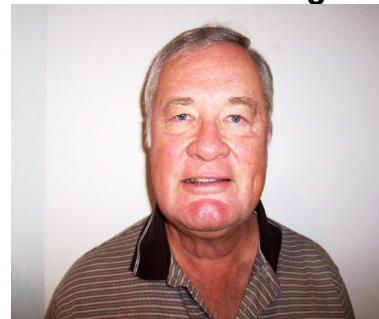

##### **Jan Schneider – *Where to From Here?***

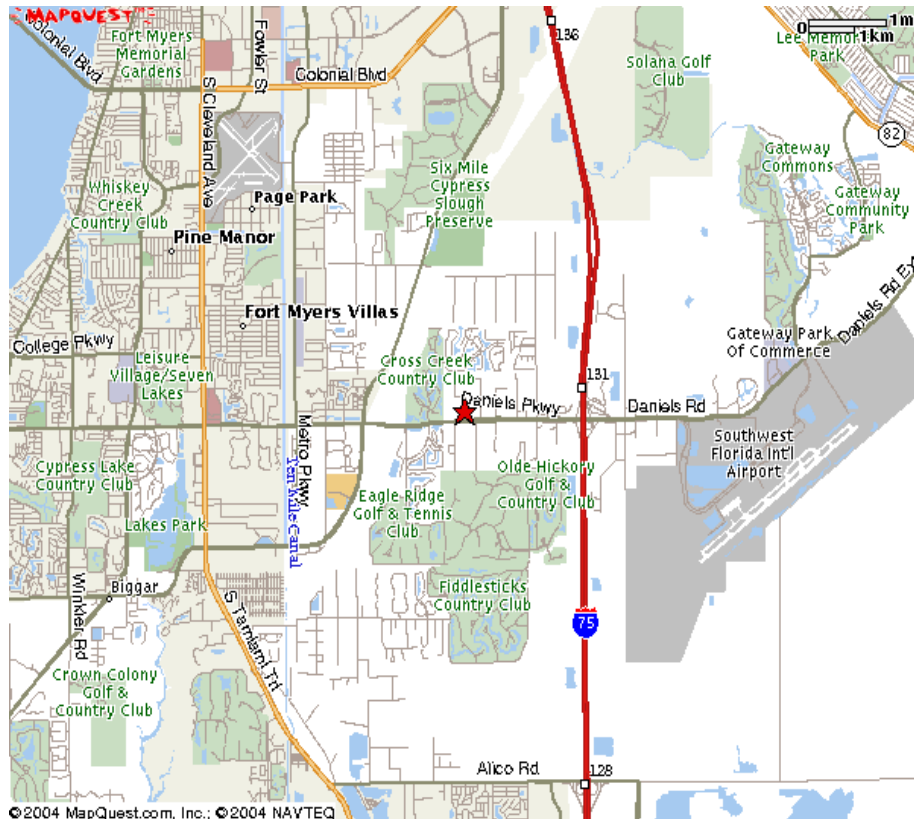
Ph.D. in political science from Yale University;
