



## Florida Leadership School January 22-28, 2006 Oviedo, Florida

Leadership School is an opportunity to explore ways that you can understand your personal style as you look forward to leading one of our Unitarian Universalist Congregations. In these six days of training we focus on three major areas of leadership development:

- Leadership skills in congregations
- Worship and congregational life
- Leadership and our UU history and tradition,

The six days of intense work offer many opportunities for personal growth, one on one exploration, role play, team building and reflection. We have experienced facilitators to lead our students and establish an exciting learning community to insure that your experience is full, challenging and helps you grow in knowledge and faith. We focus on ways that congregations are like other non-profit institutions and the ways they are not. Healthy congregational life and behaviors and conflict management are covered in depth.

Look around your congregation. Do you see a glimmer of leadership in the members around you that just needs a bit of confidence and knowledge to allow it to shine? This school is an opportunity for your congregation to invest in its future. We ask that congregations choose their students carefully as those who they assume will take on their congregation's leadership challenge in the future.

The cost for this six day program is \$700.00 per student and includes all lodging (double occupancy), meals and fees. It does not include transportation to Oviedo. The Florida District has scholarship money available if your congregation needs help to make this happen in your congregation. Preferences are made for scholarship requests for congregations who are sending their first student to the school.
