Co-facilitation teams of youth and adult members of the Florida District Youth Programs Committee will be available for cluster conversations as part of the *Consultation on Ministry to and with Youth*. This is a very organic process. It is not a cookie cutter, one-size-fits-all approach. It is a deep conversation dealing with congregational realities and innovative ideas. It will be both empowering and practical. The process will help develop plans for each individual congregation. It will also be the beginning of relationship building between participating congregations.

Congregations can also choose to have these conversations independently.
