Edd Doerr, board member or president of the American Humanist Association for more than 50 years, is the afternoon speaker.

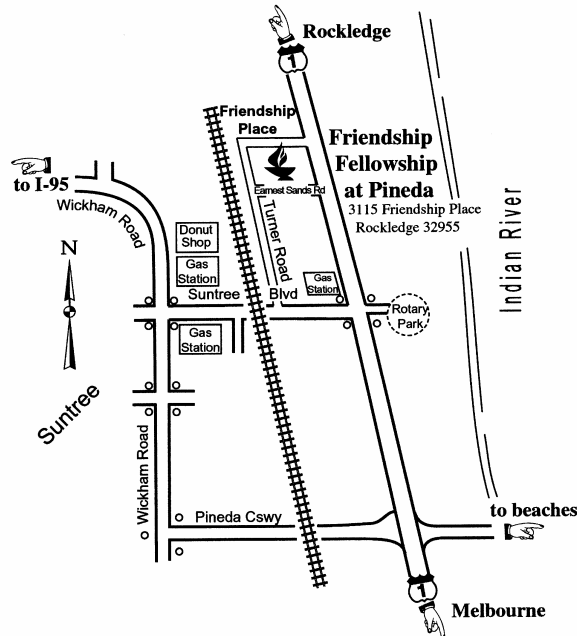
As such he has spoken to American Humanist Association groups throughout the country and has been the featured speaker at dozens of UU churches and fellowships.
