A Workshop

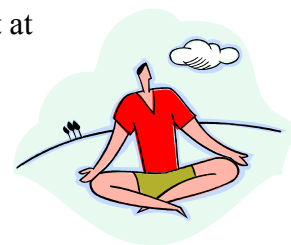

- Writings from the Great Religions (i.e., Bible, Koran, Upanishads)

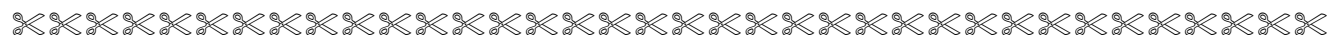
